WINTER SOWING

Milk Gallon Greenhouses

INSTRUCTIONS

Start by cutting the top of a milk gallon with a sharp blade. Make sure to leave a small portion intact to act as a hinge.

Next, poke holes at the bottom of the gallon for drainage purposes. This step is important to prevent waterlogging and root rot.

Fill the gallon about two-thirds full with potting soil.

Now it's time to sow your seeds!

Gently press down on the soil to ensure good seed-to-soil contact and moisten it lightly with water.

Close gallon, tape edges if needed. Leave lid off and set outside in a sunny location.

What You Will Need

Milk Gallons, or clear container
Box Cutter
Soil
Seeds of your choice
